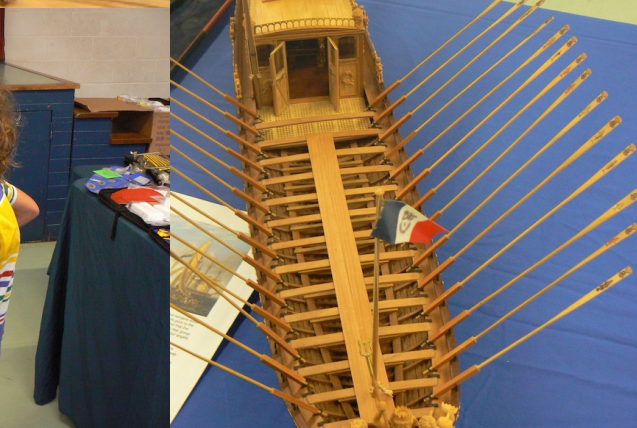

SETTING UP. Start with a blank canvas - and somehow it all comes together. Have we done this before? Well, not for three years.





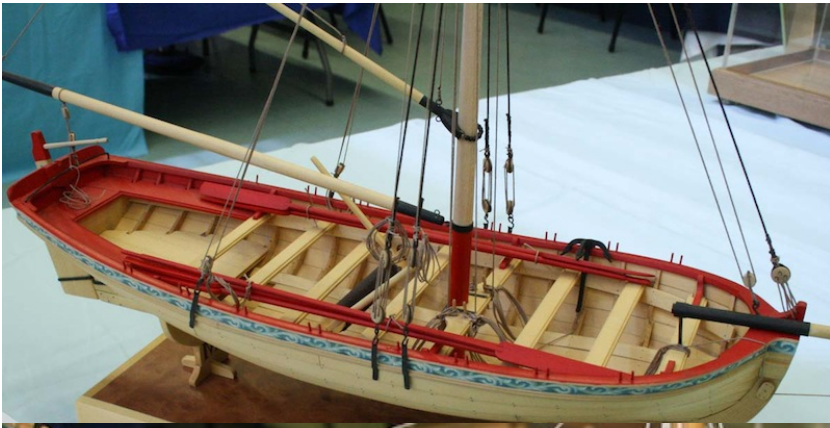
